"19. Blasting

Blasting will be allowed on this project. The Contractor shall conduct a pre-blast survey of all structures in the vicinity of proposed areas of blasting using an independent qualified pre-blast survey firm. The Contractor shall utilize controlled blasting methods so as not to overshoot and shall be liable for damage to utilities and structures due to his operation."

5. <u>Detailed Specifications, Section 4. Gravity Sewers, Force Main, Manholes, and Appurtenances, Paragraph 21. Connection of Existing Structures Served by Septic Tanks, Page DS 4-25:</u>

Add the following paragraph to the end of this Section:

"21. Connection of Existing Structures Served by Septic Tanks

The Contractor shall furnish all investigative work, materials, labor and incidental items related to intercepting the existing building sewer service between the building and existing septic tank and installing new 6-inch sewer service pipe from the interceptor connection to the proposed sewer service cleanout at the property line. The Contractor shall employ a plumber licensed in the Commonwealth of Kentucky for all work to be performed on private property. The Contractor shall be paid for the subject work on a lump sum basis for each structure; no additional payment will be made for 6-inch sewer pipe or any other items under separate pay items in the BID FORM. The four properties and suspected septic tank locations are depicted at Exhibit A attached to the end of this Section."

<u>Note:</u> Questions or Requests for Information from Contractors answered by Addendum are not included in this document.

- 1. The Engineer and Owner described the following at the Pre-Bid Meeting:
 - a. Project quantities were described.
 - b. Pre-bid requirements were discussed.
 - c. Time of Completion is 210 calendar days.
 - d. Contractor shall have competent and experienced employees assigned to this project. The bidders attention is called to Article 7 of the General Conditions and Paragraph 34. Undesirable Workmen of Section 1.
 - e. Davis Bacon wage rates apply and were checked 10 days prior to bid opening by HWEA.
 - f. DBE and WBR requirements apply to this project.
 - g. American Iron and Steel requirements apply.
 - h. A project sign is required as indicated in the project manual.
 - i. Described the general components of Addendum No. 1.
- 2. The bidders were cautioned that the bores for this project must be correct and to qualify competent forces for this work.
- 3. The crossing of the 36-inch raw water line is critical.
- 4. Bidders may probe the wheat field at the manhole locations but take care to minimize disturbance to the existing crop. HWEA will locate water lines but bidders are required to call in and locate all other utilities.
- 5. The notice to proceed will be issued as soon as reasonably possible after approval by KIA, contract documents are issued, and the preconstruction meeting is conducted.
- 6. The pre-bid meeting was mandatory to be able to submit a bid for this project.

ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for **90** days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

ARTICLE 3 – BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIONS

- 3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:
 - A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, and any data and reference items identified in the Bidding Documents, and hereby acknowledges receipt of the following Addenda:

- B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related reports and

- drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.
- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.

The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.
